

From the FRFF Workshop 1st Circular -

The goal of the FRFF Workshop is to **develop recommendations to the IVS Directing Board on the definition of the VLBI2010 radio frequencies and the specifications for VLBI2010 feeds.**

Fixing these parameters is important for future VLBI2010 developments and the realization of VLBI2010 antennas such as the German Twin Telescope Wettzell (TTW). Toward that end, talks and discussions will address possible options for observation frequency ranges that will allow VLBI2010 systems to achieve the VLBI2010 goal of 1-mm position accuracy in 24 hours, within the real-world constraints imposed by RFI, feed and antenna design, broadband receiver technology, calibration, and other factors.
